David Burbidge: Physical and Vocal Warm-up Tutor

David Burbidge lives in Sedbergh near Kendal where for several years he has led cultural exchanges between Sedbergh and Zrece in the former Yugoslavian republic of Slovenia, hailed by diplomats as the most successful and active of all town twinning projects.

He has led the Discover your Voice class at the Kendal Brewery Arts Centre for over 15 years, using movement, creativity, and group interaction to free the natural voice. His influences include Augusto Boal, Frankie Armstrong and Kristen Linklater. He also leads the Brewery Harmony singing ensemble and the South Lakeland community folk choir, Lakeland Voices, which involves singing in outdoor locations throughout the Lake District. The group sing songs from around the world in several different languages.

The warm ups will draw on his training in several different disciplines including yoga, Feldenkrais, and the Alexander Technique and will include games, movement and group interaction to free up the body and voice for movement and expression.
